

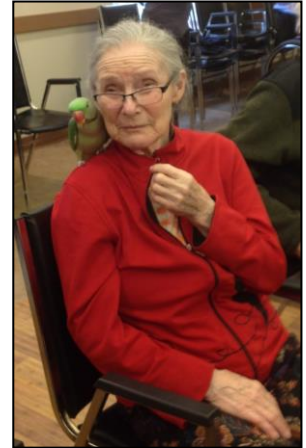


A VISIT FROM KOA & TIKO

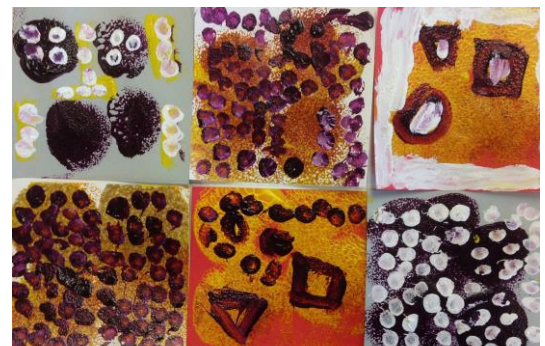
OPENING MINDS THROUGH ART
